Learn about citrus varieties, care, and selection, both in-ground and containers. Quantyn Young will talk about pruning, planting, and fertilizing. We'll also touch on other tropical fruit trees such as bananas, mango, passion fruit, and more, including seed germination and propagation.

Quantyn Young has owned his own landscaping design and consulting company here in the Sacramento area since 2006. Previously he was the manager of Fair Oaks Boulevard Nursery in Sacramento, where he worked for the past fifteen years.



He has been a University of California Sacramento County Cooperative Extension Program Master Gardener since 2011. He is the current project co-lead for the Fair Oaks Horticulture Center Demonstration Orchard.

Quantyn also appears on local radio and television stations. He has had his own garden and landscape design and installation company for over twenty years, both in the San Francisco bay area and Sacramento valley area. His designs highlight water efficient plants and edible landscaping. Quantyn is also a United States Returned Peace Corps Volunteer, having served in northern Thailand.
