Sun City Lincoln Hills Garden Group

Bylaws as of January 1, 2017

Article I. Name

The name of this group shall be Sun City Lincoln Hills Garden Group, hereinafter referred to as "the Garden Group."

Article II. Purpose

- 1. The Garden Group is organized and will operate in full compliance with the Association's governing documents, including the Club Information & Guidelines Handbook.
- 2. The stated purpose of the Garden Group:

We, the Sun City Lincoln Hills Garden Group, will support the community by providing educational opportunities through classes, tours, and advice in addition to participation in local civic gardening needs.

Article III. Membership

Membership in the Garden Group is open and restricted to all Association residents.

Article IV. Meetings

Members will be provided advance notice for the time and location of all Garden Group general membership, social and Steering Committee meetings.

Article V. Voting

The elected officials of the Steering Committee will be elected by the Garden Group's general membership.

Article VI. Records and Reports

- 1. The Garden Group is responsible for internal financial transactions and records, including any tax responsibilities, and has the responsibility to report appropriate financial business to its members.
- All Garden Group governing documents, including any meeting minutes and financial records, must be available for review by any Garden Group member in good standing.
- The Garden Group will maintain a current list of at least two Garden Group contacts with phone numbers and email addresses, and submit it to the SCLHCA Room Booking and Club Coordinator.
- 4. Lists containing Garden Group member information shall not be used for commercial, political or personal purposes not related to the business of the Garden Group.

Article VII. Group Dissolution

In the event that the Garden Group dissolves, all remaining assets will be either returned to Garden Group members or donated to a charitable organization. Dissolution will not be initiated until all outstanding debts are satisfied.

Article VIII. Amendments

Bylaw amendments must be approved by the Garden Group general membership prior to being submitted to the CCOC for review and recommendation to the Association's Board of Directors for approval. They will become effective after final approval by the Association's Board of Directors.
